ELEVATING EDUCATOR EXPERTISE

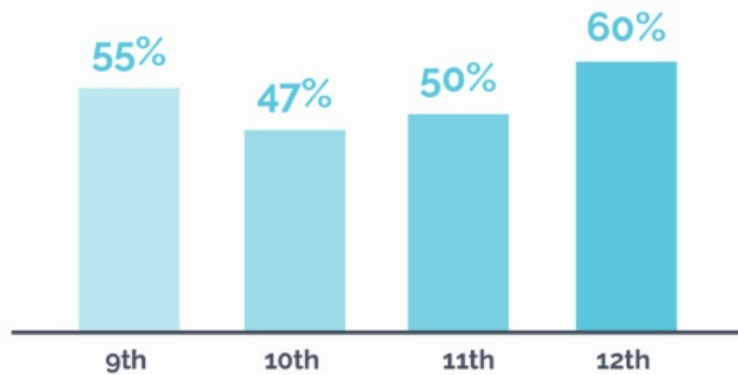

Students who report having a specific step-by-step plan for getting into the postsecondary programs of their dreams.



Data from several high schools in South Seattle and South King County shows that only 60 percent of 12th graders report having a specific step-by-step plan for getting into the postsecondary program of their dreams. DiscoverU is an excellent opportunity to kickoff high school and beyond planning with students, explore career pathways, or introduce students to postsecondary and on-the-job training options.
